Regulation of the Academic Advisor

*As approved by the Steering Committee decision no. 81702/2023

The Academic Advisor is provided by the School of Law of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and its primary focus is on students, particularly in their academic and future professional careers. The Academic Advisor for the students of the "LLM in International & European Law" was appointed by the Faculty Assembly (decision 26.4.2023) and is a faculty member of the Department of International Studies.

1. The Academic Advisor:

- Discusses and guides students on their performance in the LL.M.
- Informs students about the services offered by the Faculty.
- Informs students about the career prospects they have after completing their postgraduate studies.
- Informs students about Doctoral Studies.
- Postgraduate students can also discuss with the Academic Advisor any issue of their academic life that may arise, including issues concerning the Regulations and the Programme of Studies, problems with courses or lectures, or even personal difficulties that may affect their studies.
- 3. In addition, the academic advisor may call a meeting with a student, if so, requested by a member of the department who identifies problems of any kind, for example, consistent absences, low grades, etc.
- 4. The academic advisor makes the necessary suggestions or recommendations to the students, of a non-binding character, without being able to guarantee, however, a solution to every problem.
- 5. The meeting with the Academic Advisor is by appointment. At the meeting, the student's details and anything else considered important (e.g. learning problems, mobility problems, etc.) are recorded.
- 6. The content of the discussions is confidential, and the student's record protected by the General Data Protection Regulation.
